1st stage: Centre for Nutritional Education and Recovery (CREN) constructiond. . Finished by october 2009

2nd stage: CREN furnishment and sanitary staff training: deadline March 2010

3rd stage :CREN inauguration and starting activities March-April 2010

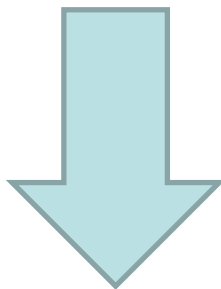
4th stage: Capacity buiding program for the local health agents in the villages. May 2010

5th stage: Asistance and nutritional control through a movile unity Program CTC: Comunitty-based Therapeutic Care.

6th phase : mBASSE: mHealth project implementation : Building African Health SyStems in rural communitiEs

Where we are?

1st stage: Centre for Nutritional Education and Recovery (CREN) construction. Finished by october 2009



2nd stage: CREN furnishment and sanitary staff training: deadline March 2010

What do we urgently need to move on from 1st to 2nd stage?

Ministry of Health:

- **MOH shall provide CREN with 3 nurses and 3 nurse assistants**
- **MOH shall provide electricity access and usage**
- **MOH shall assume that the Project budget will be free of Governmental Offsetting such as taxes, duties and other arrangements . ie –Car.**

What do we urgently need to move on from 1st to 2nd stage?

*National Nutrition Agency

NaNA will provide CREN with the micronutrient supplements (vitamin A, iron and iodine) and other nutritional supplements such as RUTF.

NANA will also provide available training material for the capacity building/training of health personnel and the Community Health Agents and will also be in charge together with NSF of training the nurses in the management of malnutrition.

What do we urgently need to move on from 1st to 2nd stage?

The Regional Health Team Upper River Basse

RHT will discuss with NSF all the technically related performance plans addressing this stage of the Project .

Equipment and other materials will be purchased according to the MOH standards and through RHT procurement channels.

What do we urgently need to move on from 1st to 2nd stage?

Ministry of Local Government, Lands & Religious Affairs
Office of the Governor, Upper River Region, Basse

MOHL shall maintain in good conditions the access to CREN by backfilling the acces road after the rainy season

MOHL will actively collaborate so as to achieve the efficient functioning of CREN and its activities
